FONZY OFRENEO EXCELS IN HIPPO INTERNATIONAL ENGLISH LANGUAGE COMPETITION

Alfonso Rafael "Fonzy" Ofreneo, Sixth Grader, obtained a perfect score in the 2018 HIPPO 6th International English Language Competition. Moreover, Ofreneo qualified in the Semi Finals of the said competition.

Hippo and its "English Without Borders" Competition is an international competition which promotes English language, challenges students around the globe to compete in English language knowledge, and improves the co-operation between teachers. The competition encourages the development of a shared sense of identity and integration, serves as a role model

for young people living together as one community. The main goal is to create and nourish friendly relations, international understanding and a spirit of sporting competitiveness between young people interested in English language from all around the world. This contest uses the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) for Languages, an international standard for describing language ability, promotes the English language, and challenges students around the globe to compete in English knowledge.

The competition will run in three rounds: Preliminary Round, Semi-Final Round, and Final Round. Fonzy passed the Semi-Final Round and he is to participate in the Final Round on March 17, 2018.

In the elections scheduled on **April 06, 2018**, the following positions may be filled-in by interested students:

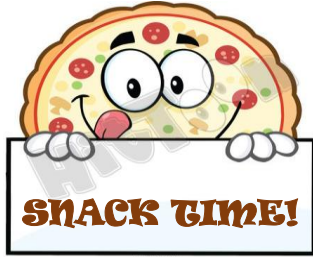
