CSN & PASS NOTICE DISTRIBUTION ON JAN. 9

A student's class standing is based on his or her performance in quizzes, long test, homeworks, seatworks, recitations, projects and the like. All of this make up the 70% of child's total class standing. The remaining thirty percent is allotted to the term test score. Please be guided by the following remarks that you may find in the notice:

ON TARGET: If the student obtained a percentage rating of 56% and up prior to the term test.

AT RISK: If the student obtained a percentage rating of 53-55% prior to the term test.

DELAYED: If the student obtained a percentage rating of 52% and below prior to the term test.

The Class Standing Notice for the 2nd Term will be released on **January 9, 2018**. In case you do not receive it, please get in touch with your child's class adviser so you may receive a copy. After receiving a copy, please discuss it with your child, and fill out and return the reply slip on or before **January 16, 2018**. Parents or guardians of students who are not meeting standards may request for a conference with the teacher so that the deficient areas could be addressed as early as possible.

The Class Standing Notice (CSN) and P.A.S.S. Current Status serve as an advance parental notice on the child's commitment and ability to take responsibility for his or her own learning.
