Reminders

It's a new year so let us be refreshed with some of the school's rules and reminders!

FETCHERS' GUIDELINES. The school always prioritizes safety and security of the children, thus, parents must inform the office if their children will be picked up by other people who are not carrying a guardian's I.D. Children will not be released to any unauthorized person unless **the office is duly informed in writing** that someone other than the parents or authorized fetcher will fetch the child from school. **All fetchers must wear proper, decent, and appropriate clothes with fetcher's ID and must observe proper decorum when inside the school premises.**

STAYING IN THE CAMPUS AFTER REGULAR HOURS. Only academic and sports varsity members and students are allowed to stay beyond class hours based on their training schedule. However, some co-curricular activities of other students outside the regular school hours may also be held on certain days at specified time, as long as there is permission from their parents through a letter or note in the diary.

ON BRINGING OF CLASS REQUIREMENTS. All school requirements like assignments, projects, class materials, P.E. uniforms and the like should be brought by the students when he/she comes to school in the morning. **Drivers and caregivers are not allowed to bring the class requirements later in the day, disturbing the classes of intended recipients.**

It is also defined as a goal that is **ethical, economical, efficient and visionary** to guide people in having a resourceful lifestyle, in which discarded materials can be re-designed as resources for others to use.

Cut your household emissions by up to 10% by using energy-saving lightbulbs and up to 50% reduction by choosing energy efficient whitegoods. **Good for the planet, good for your electricity bill.**




REUSE REFILL YOUR OWN DRINK BOTTLE

Single-use plastic bottles generate an enormous amount of waste that is ending up in landfill, oceans, and waterways. Refill your own stainless steel or BPA-free bottle. **You can save money, too!**

RECYCLE AVOID NON-RECYCLABLES

Avoid packaging that won't go in your recycle bin, like styrofoam. Plastic packaging marked code 1, 2 or 3 can usually be recycled; several councils now also accept codes 4-7. **Check with your local council.**
