GS SCIENCE CAMP SLATED ON FEBRUARY 1-2

The Grade School Department will be holding its annual Science Camp on February 1-2, 2019 at Stonyhurst Southville International School – Malarayat Campus. The camping will focus on the theme **Climate Change: Understanding, Reducing, and Adapting.**



The camping will start at 3:00 PM of February 1 and will end at 10:00 AM of February 2. A letter was sent informing parents of notifying the advisers of the children's allergies and food preferences. Please make sure to have coordinated with your child's adviser regarding this matter. The schedule of activities was also released.


This year, the camping will also feature the Science Mobile Education Event (included in the camping fee). Also, all students' outputs from the activities will be graded and recorded as integrated tasks across subjects.

Since the camping will be an overnight activity, students need to bring the following:

- Label your child's things with his/her name.
- Students must wear their PE uniform and bandana. On the 2nd day, students are required to wear their Rigor shirt and any jogging pants.
