KINGS CLAIM TOP SPOTS IN SGEN MUSIC AND MONOLOGUES

Four talented Kings showcased their acting and singing skills and claimed the top spots in the first ever SGEN Performing Arts Competition: Music and Monologues last February 20, 2019.

The Music and Monologues is a competition focusing on the acting and singing skills of the participants under two categories – musical and pop. A school has two representatives for each category – one for monologue and one for song. The monologue is therefore a prelude to the song performance.

Gelyannah R. Villarama (9 Argentina) won **1st Place** for the Monologue Performance in the Musical Category while **Eisen Klein G. Villanueva** (12 South Africa) also won **1st Place** for the Monologue Performance in the Pop Category. Taking the **2nd Place** for the Song Performance in the Musical Category is **Stephanie Ann H. Castillo** (11 Egypt) with her rendition of "As If We Never Said Goodbye" from the musical *Sunset Boulevard*. **Jan Emanuel A. Guico** (12 South Africa) was also hailed **2nd Place** for the Pop Category in his version of Aegis' "Basang-basa sa Ulan."

This year's SGEN Music and Monologues was hosted by Stonyhurst Southville International School – Malarayat Campus and was participated by the six SGEN schools – SSIS Malarayat, SSIS Batangas, South Mansfield College (SMC), SEED Academy, Southville International School and Colleges (SISC), and Southville International School Affiliated with Foreign Universities (SISFU).
