enroll and avail of our discounts EARLY ENROLMENT FOR 2019-2020 STARTS ON MARCH 18

Starting March 18, 2019, Stonyhurst Southville International School - Malarayat Campus will implement the early enrolment discount for AY 2019-2020. For the incoming school year, there will be a minimal 3-5% increase in tuition fee costs. This increase will cover the rising inflation costs and the improvement of school infrastructure. The following are the options for early enrolment discount:

EARLY ENROLMENT DISCOUNT

Plan A	2,500.00
Plan B	1,500.00
Plan C	1,000.00

MODE OF PAYMENT DISCOUNT

Plan A	3,000.00
Plan B	1,500.00

Also, prior to early enrolment, reservation may be made to secure a slot in a class. Slots are still open for Grades 1-6, Grades 7-10 and Senior High School (Grades 11-12). Slots for Nursery/Pre-Kinder AM and all PM sessions are still available.

We would like to encourage you to reserve your slot as this would help the school in its planning and preparation for the next school year, to best benefit your children. Please note that no reservation shall be honored without paying the reservation fee of 5,000.00 (per child) in the Accounting Office.

However, the early enrolment discount will adhere to the following considerations: (1) The student must not be in any academic probationary case; (2) The student must not be in any disciplinary probationary case; and (3) All fees and financial accountabilities for AY 2018-2019 must have been settled prior to early enrolment. Aside from the early enrolment, you will also be given sibling discount if you are sending more than one child to SSIS. The discounts are as follows:

No. of Children	Discount
2 (on the 2 nd child)	2,000.00
3 (on the 3 rd child)	4,000.00
4 (on the 4 th child)	6,000.00

The early enrolment for Academic Year 2019-2020 will run until April 30, 2019.
