SSIS GETS READY FOR YEAR-END ACTIVITIES

The end of the school year is just around the corner! As we celebrate yet another fulfilling and successful school year, please be informed of the initial details of year-end activities that the school is gearing up for.

CLOSING PROGRAM. This year's closing program will be divided into three programs – one for preschool which is slated on **May 20, 2019** at 9-11 AM; one for Grades 1 to 4 (**May 21, 9-11 AM**) and another one for Grades 5 -12 (**May 21, 6-8 PM**). The preschool closing program will feature songs from *Disney* movies. The Grades 1-4 Closing Program will perform songs from the movie *Trolls* while Grades 5-12 are preparing for an ensemble of *The Greatest Showman* performances.

The preschool closing program will accommodate 2 seats for the parents and 2 seats for the guests per family while the GS and HS closing programs will only accommodate 2 seats for parents and 1 seat for a guest per family.

RECOGNITION DAY. The school will hold four (4) recognition ceremonies this year. The Preschool (Nursery, Pre-Kinder & Junior Kinder) Recognition Day is scheduled on **May 23, 2019 (Thursday)** while Grades 1-2 students are to be recognized on **May 24, 2019 (Friday)**. On the other hand, Grades 3-5 students will be recognized on **May 30, 2019 (Thursday)** while Grades 7-11 are scheduled on **May 31, 2019 (Friday)**. All ceremonies will be from 9:00 to 11:00 AM. The High School Recognition Day will also feature the Moving-Up Ceremony of Grade 10 students to Senior High School.

The preschool and high school recognition days will accommodate 2 seats for the parents and 3 seats for the guests per awardee; while the Grade 1-2 and Grades 3-5 recognition will accommodate 2 seats for the parents and 2 seats for the guests per awardee.

SENIOR KINDER MOVING-UP CEREMONY. The Senior Kinder Moving-Up Ceremony will be held on **June 6, 2019 (Thursday)**, 9:00-11:00 AM, in the school gym. The moving-up ceremony will limit to seven (7) seats per family including the parents.

GRADES 6 & 12 GRADUATION. The Grades 6 & 12 Graduation is scheduled on **June 7, 2019 (Friday)**. Grade 6 will have their ceremony in the morning, 8:00-10:00 AM; while Grade 12 will be in the evening at 6:00-8:00 PM – both will be held in the school gym. The graduation will limit to seven (7) seats per family including the parents.
