JOIN THE GEM AWARDS



When students have developed growth mindset, they will be able to see effort as a positive behaviour and become more resilient to face failure and attain higher academic outcomes. It is for this reason that Stonyhurst Southville International School-Malarayat Campus is launching the **Growing the Extra Mile (GEM) Award**. **As a requirement for the GEM Award, any SSIS student from Grades 1-12 must conceptualize, design and accomplish an original project (in whatever form), documented through a video presentation.**

HOW CAN I JOIN?

1. All students from Grades 1-12 are eligible to qualify for the GEM Award.
2. Interested students must register for the GEM Award at the Principal's Office.
3. Students will start their Growth Mindset Project anytime from September to February of the academic year.
4. Entry for the Growth Mindset Project should be in a form of a video.
5. All participants should undergo a panel interview and presentation of their Growth Mindset Project.

CRITERIA FOR THE GEM AWARD

The recipient of the GEM Award will be chosen through the following criteria:

- A. Character – learns from his/her mistakes and is not afraid to try it again.
- B. Collaboration – asks questions
- C. Commitment to Achieve – focuses on tasks
- D. Competence – applies effective strategies
- E. Creativity – takes risks

ANNOUNCEMENT OF AWARDEES

- A. A congratulatory letter will be given to the awardee.
- B. The recipient of the award will be awarded during the Recognition and Graduation Days.

Any child may be an awardee for the school year provided that they accomplish all the tasks and pass the presentation and panel interview. Hence, there may be more than one awardee per department at the end of the year. Entries that do not pass (not yet) the standards of the panel will carry over the project for the following year.
