SSIS CONGRATULATES TULA-LALALA WINNERS

The celebration of the Language Month was a blast through the Tula-lalala Festival held last September 3, 5 and 12, 2019.

Several contests were interspersed in the celebration and they are the following: *Sabayang Pagbigkas* for High School, *Paligsayaw* for Grade School, and *Paligsahan sa Grupong Pag-awit* for the ECED.

Grade 12 South Africa won 1st Place in the *Sabayang Pagbigkas*; followed by **Grade 11 Egypt** and **Grade 10 Peru**. For the *Paligsayaw*, **Grade 3 India** emerged as the Champion in their performance of "Mga Kababayan" by Francis Magalona. **Grade 6 China** and **Russia** tied in 2nd Place while **Grade 5 Iran** bagged the 3rd Place. **Grade 1 Germany and Greece** aced the Group Singing Competition bagging 1st Place, in their performances of *Magtanim ay Di Biro* and *Bahay Kubo* respectively. **Grade 2 Finland and Spain** snatched the 2nd Place; and **Grade 1 Hungary**, 3rd Place.

REGISTRATION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ON ABSENCES. According to the Department of Education Manual of Regulations for Private Schools, **students with absences reaching 20%, which is 40 days, of the total number of school days shall be automatically dropped from the roll without the benefit of an appeal and without refund of fees paid regardless whether the absences are excused or unexcused.**

Parents are advised to apply a Leave of Absences at the Principal's Office if the child will be absent for more than 5 consecutive school days, a week before the said date. An Academic Undertaking will be signed by the student and the parents once the Leave of Absence is approved.

Habitual absences may necessitate the retention of a student on the same level at the end of the school year. Those who have incurred absences regardless of the reason are held responsible for all school work missed during their absence.

REQUESTING AND RELEASING OF ACADEMIC SCHOOL RECORDS. As per DepEd Order no. 48 s. 2017, request for **all Academic School Records** shall be filed and claimed by any of the following, subject to the presentation of a valid proof of affinity to the minor learner as stated below:

- Parent** – Birth Certificate of the minor learner
- Brother or Sister of legal age** - Birth Certificate of the minor learner and the brother or sister
- Legal Guardian** – court order

In case a request shall be filed by a representative, the person shall be duly authorized in writing through a valid Special Power of Attorney (SPA) duly executed by the applicant specifically stating the name of the representative and the purpose of its issuance.

Preschool SKIP on Sept 27

On September 27, our preschool students are scheduled to have SKIP. SKIP or the **Stonyhurst Kinesthetic Intelligence Program** is one of the school programs that helps in the development of our preschool students. Done once a month, SKIP activities involve deftness and physical coordination and using the children's fine and gross motor skills. They learn and express themselves through various physical activities.

High kinesthetic intelligence is what creates scientists, writers, artists, musicians, dancers, performers, and other creative people that allow their minds and hands to move without any pre-planned format. While some are blessed with athletic abilities, others are gifted in fine motor skills, such as drawing and crafts.

A child with bodily-kinesthetic intelligence: responds very well to physical stimulus, has excellent physical skills - gross motor skills and fine motor skills, has a body with great flexibility and agility, has very dexterous hands, and tends to move around as part of their learning process.

Activities that children with bodily-kinesthetic intelligence will enjoy includes all types of hands-on activities where they can feel and touch and manipulate objects, science experiments, gardening, participating in dramas, dancing, climbing, rolling, jumping, crawling, sports, outdoor activities that involve physical stimulus - climbing a hill, hikes, walks in the forest, activities that require them to move about in a large physical space, scavenger hunts and charades.

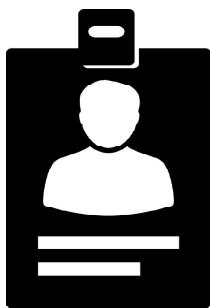
