HEALTH ADVISORY on DENGUE

Student health is one of the top priorities of the school, thus, SSIS ensures dengue prevention by conducting fogging once every two weeks. In fact, the school is scheduled to have another one this coming Saturday.

Whether at home, work or in school, we can help prevent and control dengue by doing the following:

1. Apply insect repellent throughout the day.
2. Cover exposed skin or wear long sleeves.
3. Eliminate standing water in your area.
4. Avoid outdoor activities at dawn and dusk.

Treatment

1. Do not give aspirin for fever.
2. Give sufficient amount of water or rehydrate a dengue suspect.
3. If fever or symptoms persist for 2 or more days, bring the patient to the nearest hospital.
